BY-LAW NUMBER 42-2001

**A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF FRONT OF YONGE FOR FIRE PROTECTION**

WHEREAS, Section 210, Paragraph 31 (c), the Municipal Act allows a Municipality to enter into an agreement with other Municipalities for the use of fire fighting equipment of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands deem it expedient to enter into an agreement with the Corporation of the Township of the Front of Yonge for protection;

THEREFORE, the council of the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Reeve and CAO/Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the attached agreements between the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands and the Corporation of the Township of Front of Yonge.
2. Any previous agreements for fire protection between these two municipalities are hereby repealed.

SCHEDULE "A"

To By-Law Number 42-2001

AREA OF COVERAGE

Response area within Ward 3, of the Township of Leeds and 1000 Islands (formerly the Township of the Front of Escott) as per attached map.

SCHEDULE "B"

To By-Law Number 42-2001

REMUNERATION

Remuneration for Fire Protection ONLY for the agreement area shall be \$25,000.00 for the period April 1, 2001 to March 31, 2002.

Payments are to be made 50% of the amount payable on the 1st day of May and the balance due the 1st day of October.

Schedule "C"

To By-Law Number 42-2001

1. The following are examples of the type responses that the Front of Yonge Fire Department will respond to in the agreement area and under normal circumstances it would **not** require an additional fire response from the Leeds & 1000 Islands Fire Services. Notification would be required immediately upon completion of the incident via Fire Dispatch by fax to facilitate the fire investigation where warranted.
 - Medical Calls
 - Small Rubbish/Grass Fires
 - Hydro Wires Down
 - Vehicle Fires
 - Chimney Fires
 - CO Alarm
 - Fire Alarms Ringing
 - Unauthorized Burning

2. The following are examples of responses that **would** require the Leeds & 1000 Islands Fire Services to be notified immediately via Fire Dispatch and Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services personnel and/or equipment would respond.
 - Large Structure Fires
 - Farm & Ice/Water Rescue
 - Hazardous Materials or Environmental Spills
 - Train Incidents
 - Pipeline Incidents
 - Motor Vehicle Accidents involving 3 or more vehicles
 - Fatalities
 - Suspected Arson
 - Search & Rescue
 - Any call with an expected duration of more than one (1) hour.

3. Regardless of the examples stated above the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Department will attend:
 - any call the Fire Chief or Designate feels the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services should be in attendance.
 - Any call the Front of Yonge Fire Department Officer-in-Charge feels that should involve the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services.

4. Upon the arrival and assumption of COMMAND by the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services and if in the opinion of the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services Officer-In-Charge and with the agreement of the Front of Yonge Fire Department Officer-In-Charge that, all or part of the Front of Yonge Fire Department equipment and personnel would still be required, that this continued assistance would fall under the Leeds Grenville Fire Mutual Aid Agreement.

5. That the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands shall provide a map, identifying the roads in the designated area, either alphabetically or numerically, and shall keep such map updated at all times.
6. That this agreement may be cancelled by either of the Parties hereto upon six (6) months notice in writing, delivered to the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of the Front of Yonge or to the Clerk of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands.





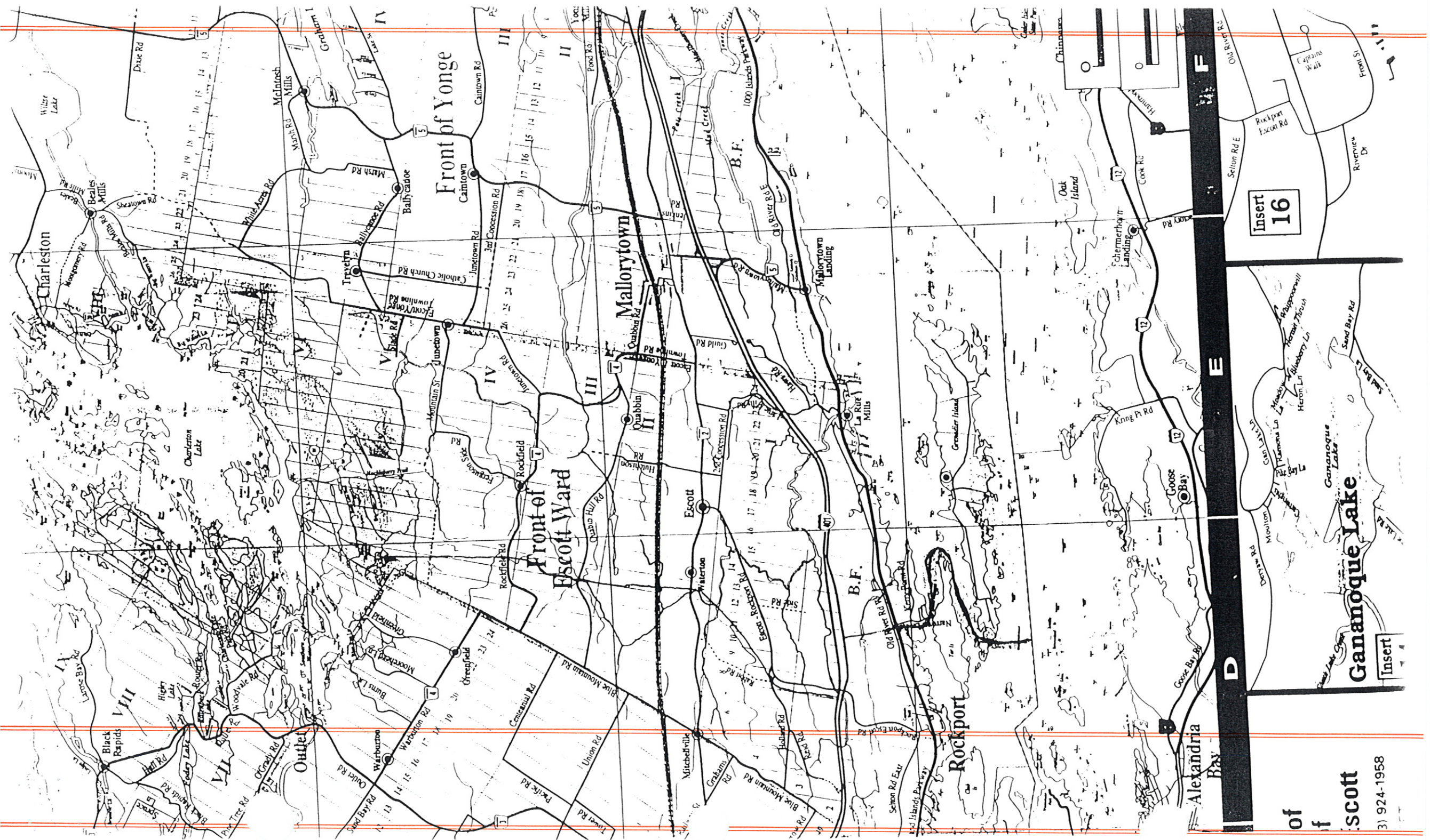
THIS AGREEMENT, made in duplicate this 23 day of April, 2001.

BETWEEN: THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF THE FRONT OF YONGE IN THE COUNTY OF LEEDS hereinafter called The Township of the FIRST PART and THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEEDS AND THE THOUSAND ISLANDS IN THE COUNTY OF LEEDS hereinafter called the Township of the SECOND PART.

For the purposes of this agreement fire protection shall be defined as rescue, suppression, ambulance assist.

WITNESS: that the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. THAT "The Township of the Front of Yonge", the Party of the First part, shall provide fire protection for The Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands, the Party of the Second Part, on the following terms and conditions;
 - a) The Township of the Front of Yonge shall supply the fire engine, tanker truck and equipment, together with the necessary firefighters, to provide Emergency Response Fire Protection in the area described in Schedule "A" attached thereto, for all property and buildings therein. Schedule "B" attached hereto provides remuneration rates for this service. Schedule "C" attached hereto provides guidelines for which responses Leeds and 1000 Islands Fire Services will also attend.
 - b) Upon receiving an emergency call in the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands and if the Front of Yonge Fire Department is unable to respond in total or in part they will immediately advise the Leeds 1000 Islands Fire Services via Fire Dispatch.
 - c) The Township of the Front of Yonge Fire Department shall notify the Leeds and 1000 Islands Fire Services immediately following the dispatch of their firefighters and equipment for those calls outlined in Schedule "C".
 - d) Upon arrival of the Leeds and 1000 Islands Fire Services it will be left to the discretion of the Officer in Charge of the Leeds and 1000 Islands Fire Services as to whether or not Front of Yonge Fire Department will remain at the scene of the incident.
 - e) The Front of Yonge Fire Department Officer-in-Charge shall determine availability of equipment.
2. That Front of Yonge shall at all times make every effort to maintain suitable equipment and trained firefighters.
3. That the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands shall keep and maintain suitable equipment and trained firefighters.
4. The Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands shall keep and maintain all Township roads in a passable condition for use of the fire protection equipment

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRONT OF YONGE
AND
THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEEDS
AND THE THOUSAND ISLANDS**

WHEREAS section 207 and 210 (s.31) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, as amended authorizes municipalities to enter into agreements for providing fire fighting and fire protection services;

AND WHEREAS the Councils for the Township of Front of Yonge and the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands deem it expedient to enter into an agreement for the provision of fire fighting and fire protection services;


AND WHEREAS the Township of Front of Yonge is to provide the services to part of the former Township of Front of Escott, now known as Ward 3 of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Front of Yonge enacts as follows:


1. That the terms of the agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law are ratified by the Township of Front of Yonge.
2. That the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law.
3. That the Schedule "A" forms part of this by-law.
4. That the effective date of this by-law shall be April 1, 2001.
5. That by-law #09-92 is hereby repealed and replaced.

READ a third time and passed this 2nd day of April 2001.
